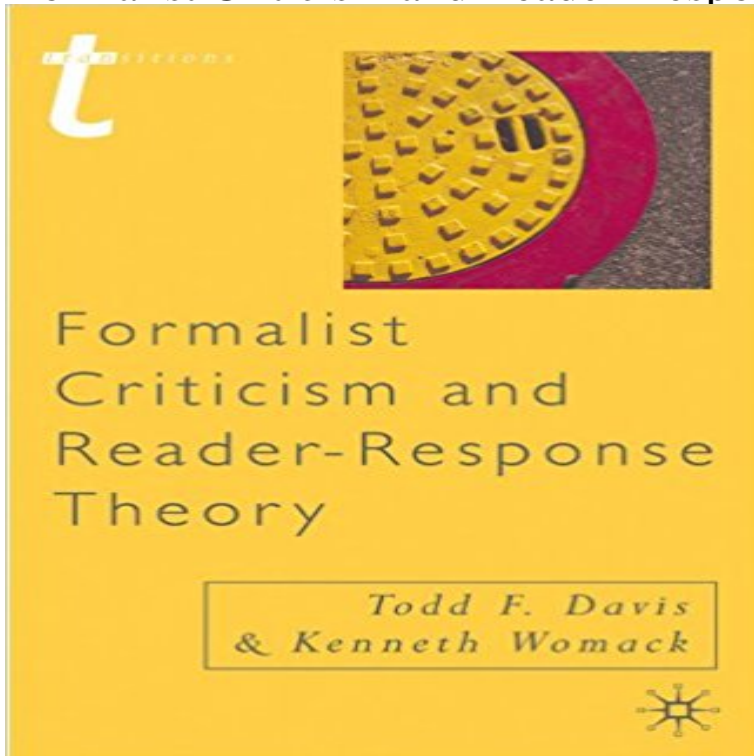


Formalist Criticism and Reader-Response Theory (Transitions)

As well as transforming the critical developments of the past by interpreting them from the perspective of the present day, each study enacts transitional readings of a number of well-known literary texts.
