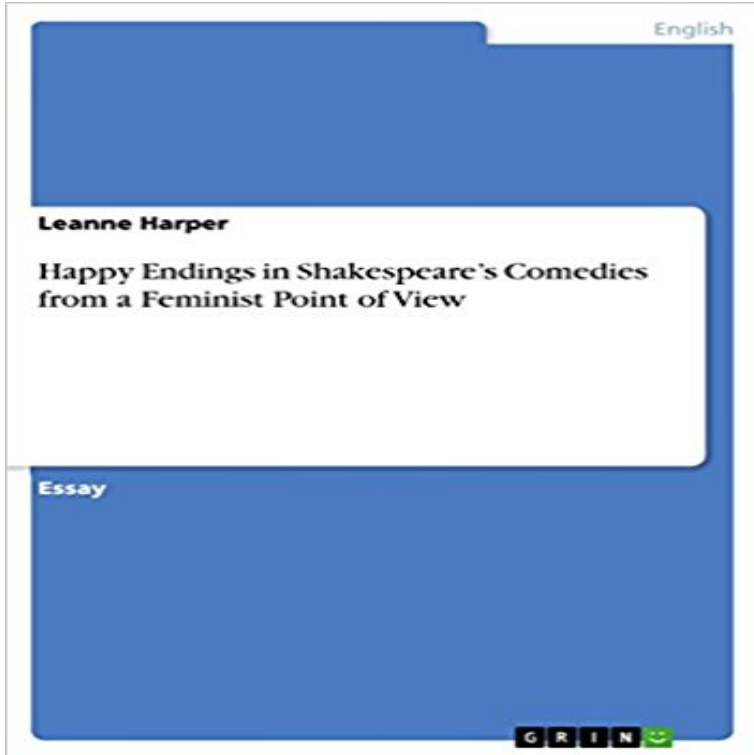


# Happy Endings in Shakespeares Comedies from a Feminist Point of View
