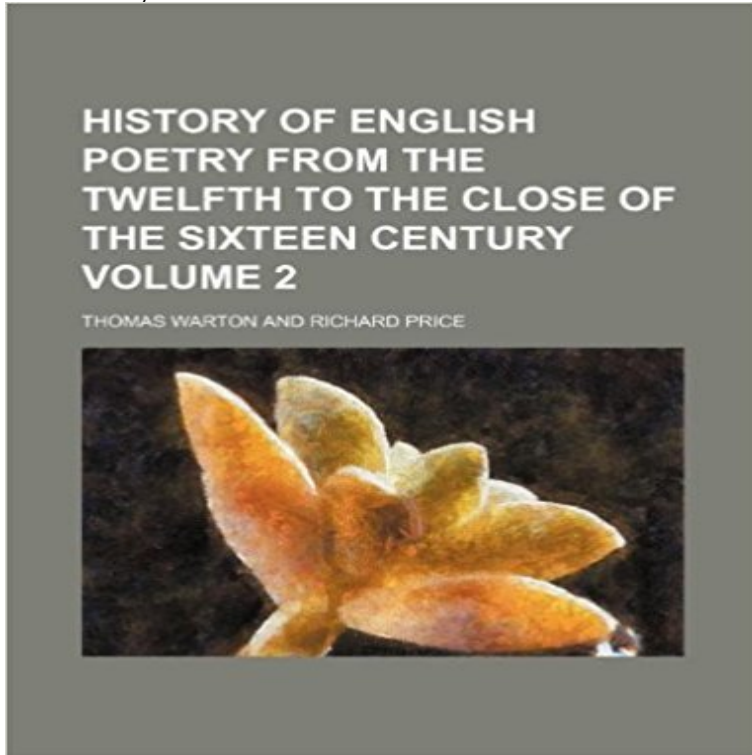

Many important romances altogether omitted and probably unseen by Warton and his editors, might be mentioned here, such as Blonde of Oxford and Jchan of Dammartin, edited for the Camden Society, 1858; Sir Generides, recently edited for the Roxburghe Club by Mr. Furnivall (a ballad-poem on the fame subject is in a MS. in the library of Trinity College, Cambridge; and of the longer narrative fragments printed with the types of W. de Worde are extant); The Romans of Partenay or Melufine, Early English Text Society, 1866; and Torrent of Portugal, printed from the Chetham MS. 1842, 8vo.
