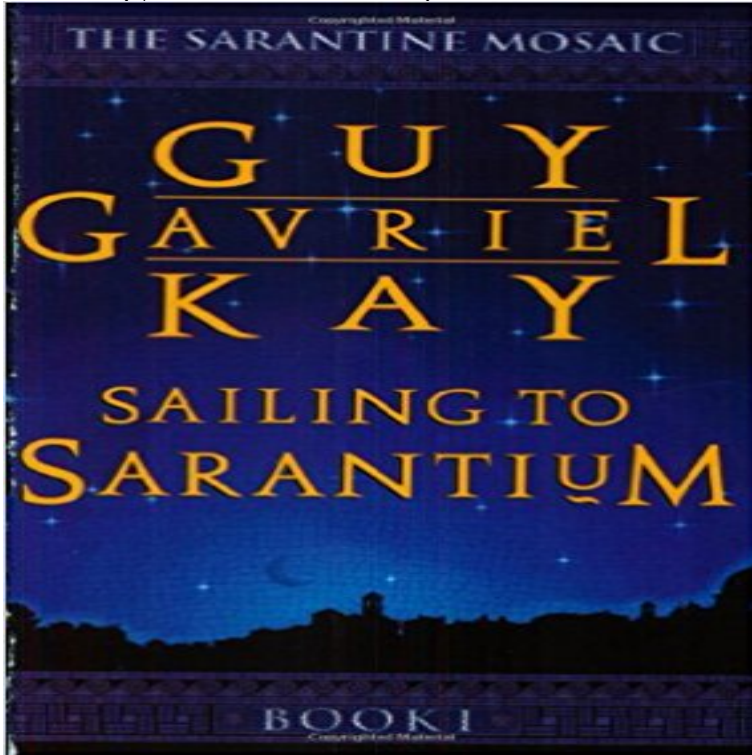


Sailing to Sarantium (The Sarantium mosaic)
