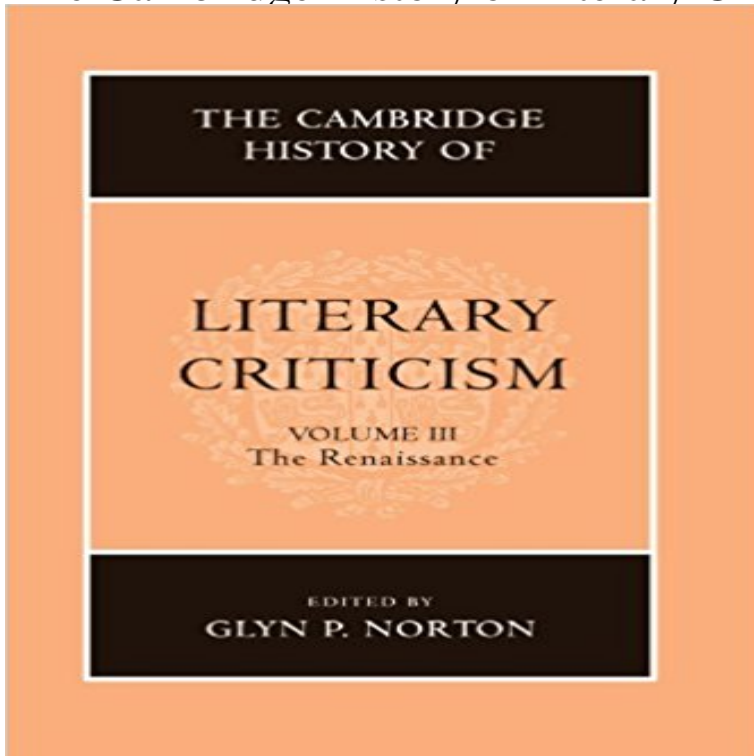


The Cambridge History of Literary Criticism, Vol. 3: The Renaissance
