
The God of Small Things

Among the vats of banana jam and heaps of peppercorns in their grandmothers factory, they try to craft a childhood for themselves amidst what constitutes their family -- their lonely, lovely mother, their beloved Uncle Chacko (pickle-baron, radical Marxist bottom-pincher) and their avowed enemy; Baby Kochamma (ex-nun and incumbent grand-aunt).
