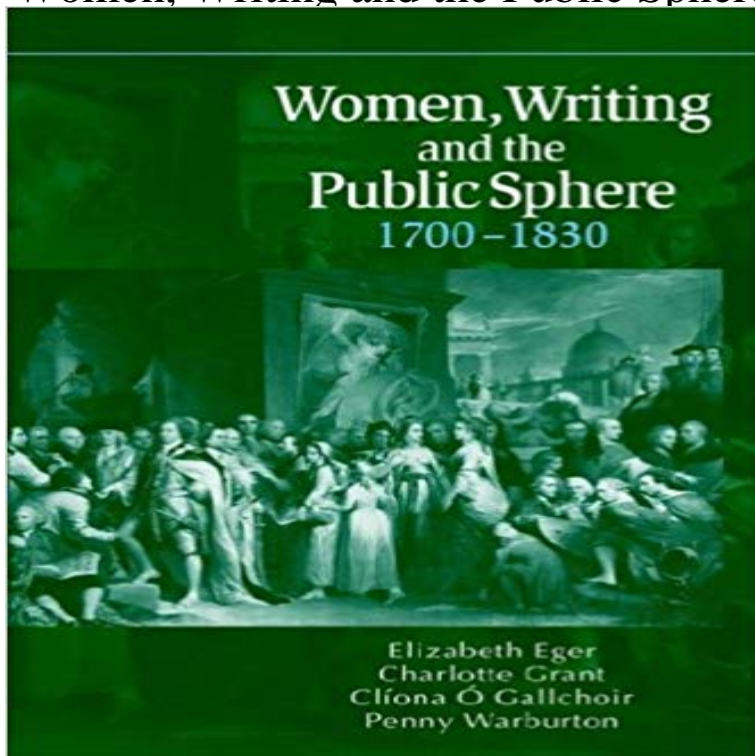


## Women, Writing and the Public Sphere, 1700-1830
