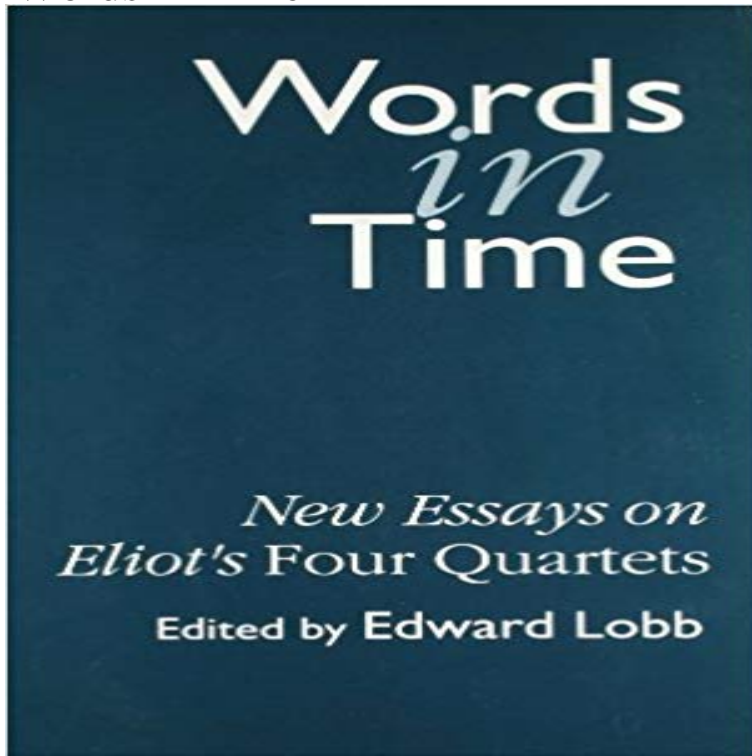


Words in Time
